Determine the resources needed

- Within BSN
- With Partner Organizations

Getting Action - Steps



Organize the Logistics

- Site selection
- Transportation requirements
 - Local government approval
- Local law enforcement notifications

Getting Action - Steps



Coordinate companion committee and membership responsibilities

- Communications
 - Outreach
 - Issues
 - Media

Getting Action - Steps



Assess potential vulnerabilities & organize appropriate supports

- Train leaders and action partners
 - Create legal team
- Monitors and marshals as per event need
- Prepare for potential child care needs

Getting Action - Other



Maintain relationships with other entities in local, state and national venues where joint action may develop, and in which BSN members will want to be participants.

Getting Action - Example



....BSN determines to create action events to support “single payer” proposals in NYS.

- Strategies include – get commitment from 10 uncommitted legislators ;
- Rally 200 people at the Capitol to lobby;
- Bring 50 recipients of health care who are endangered to the Senate and Assembly Floor
- Create a public event of a rally and march
